Costs for Camps for elective subjects are included in the Elective Subject Levies (see subject handbook). The Tuition Fees do not include books, uniforms, or other compulsory expenses.

All School Fees must be paid via Direct Debit.

Sibling discount will apply to families with two or more children simultaneously attending Christian College. The discount will only apply to the net tuition fees and not to any other charges, such as the Capital Works Levy. It will only be applied to the net tuition fees of the consecutive younger student.

DEVICE AND DIGITAL SUBSCRIPTIONS

The costs of devices for students in Years 4-12 and all required year level digital subscriptions are included within the Tuition Fees. Families are not required to make any additional payments for these resources.

The Compulsory Capital Works Fee is an annual contribution that supports the ongoing development and improvement of the school's facilities and infrastructure. This fee ensures the College can continue to provide safe, well-maintained, and well-equipped learning environments for all students. Funds from the Capital Works Fee are directed toward building projects, maintenance, and future capital improvements that benefit the entire school community.

PAYMENT OF FEES

1. Fees are generated at the start of each year, and Parents are provided Notification of Annual fees in January.
2. A 3% discount on Annual Tuition Fees is offered when full fees (less any applicable sibling discount) are paid by the specified date in February each year.
3. A payment plan can be selected of fortnightly, monthly or quarterly. The College requires Fees to be paid via automatic Direct debit from your nominated bank account or credit card.
4. Late payment may incur a late fee of \$100.

In 2026, the College will be offering elective subjects for students in Years 7 – 12. The core curriculum resources for these electives will be covered within the Tuition Fees charged, however as these subjects require additional consumable items or specialist activities (outings and camps), a separate levy needs to be applied to assist with the costs.

CAMPS & YEAR 9 RURAL EXPERIENCE

Tuition Fees cover camp experiences for students from Prep – Year 8. The Year 9 Rural Experience is also included within the Tuition Fees.

As students move into Years 10 and 11, optional tour opportunities – both within Australia and abroad – will be offered at an additional cost to families.

ENROLMENT FEE

A \$250 fee* is required at the time of lodgment. A further \$100 application fee* is payable for each additional child enrolled.

Once enrolment offers are issued a confirmation fee of \$750* will be required to secure your child's placement. This amount will be credited to your Fee Account upon commencement.

**If a child fails to commence at the College, the fee is not refunded.*

CONVEYANCING ALLOWANCE

A conveyance allowance can be claimed for either car or bus travel from the Department of Education for each eligible student. Forms must be completed and returned with the first two weeks of Term 1.

To be eligible a student must live more than 4.8km from the closest College campus. A student is not eligible if they bypass another multi/inter denominational or Christian school.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION & TRAINING (VET)

VET Delivered to School Students combines your VCE or VCE VM with accredited, practical hands-on training and experience at TAFE. Delivered over one or two years, these programs provide students with practical, job-ready skills to pathway to an apprenticeship, employment, or further study at TAFE or university. Parents will be required to meet any remaining course costs, as well as any applicable material fees each year. Transport to VET classes will also be covered by the College. The total cost will vary depending on the specific course selected.

WITHDRAWAL OF CHILDREN

If a student is to cease attending Christian College, written notification is required 10 weeks prior to leaving (excluding holidays).

Parents and guardians are to complete the Student Exit Notification form and return to your child's campus.
